The Lion Foundation Announces Grant Awards \$21,000 in 2020 Grant Awards -supporting academics, athletics and more!

The Lion Foundation kicked off 2020 by awarding \$21,000 in academic and athletic grants to the Camp Hill School District, helping to fund programs ranging from early learning support to world language proficiency.

Thanks to its generous donors, the Foundation also announced that in 2019, it gave out more than \$231,704 for academic, athletic and cultural projects and programs benefiting Camp Hill's students, schools and community – a historic high! The record amount underscores the real impact that our donors' support has on the Lion Foundation's mission of funding programs and projects not covered by taxpayer dollars.
