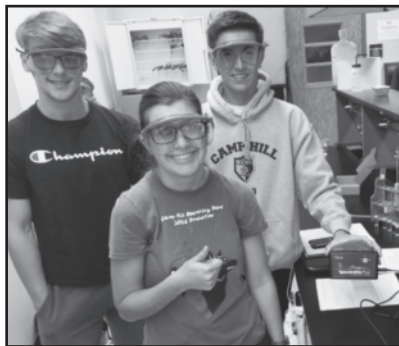
# YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK!
